### **Festival 2022**

The registration portal at [www.ottawakiwanismusicfestival.com](http://www.ottawakiwanismusicfestival.com) will open on Monday November 1st. **We strongly urge you to get your registrations in well before the deadline of December 21st so that you have time to address any technical issues without being overly stressed.**

A reminder that the Festival will be a hybrid for 2022 - the main entries will be submitted by video and adjudicated remotely as has happened for the last two Festivals. However (as long as we're allowed to do it) we will have live Trophy Classes for most of our disciplines, including Harp and Guitar. Most of the Trophy Classes will take place at St Aidan's Church on Hamlet Avenue - dates to be announced. **We're very excited to announce that the Music Theatre Trophy Class will take place at Dominion Chalmers on April 19th.**

We are almost finished putting our Adjudicator team together and will post the information to our website very soon.

**December 21, 2021** - deadline for registration for Solo Performers

**January 21, 2022** - deadline for registration for Ensembles

**February 12, 2022** - deadline for minor changes to your registrations

**February 15, 2022** - deadline for Senior Scholarship applications

**March 15, 2022** - deadline for submission of performance videos and supplementary materials, including Composition entries
